POLICY AND PROCEDURE 24.8 WINDOW KEY PROTOCOL

Purpose:

To provide unit staff with access to a window key that can be utilized to maintain a comfortable, healthy and safe environment for the patients.

Procedure:

Whiting Forensic Hospital wishes to maintain a healthy, comfortable and safe environment for patients and staff. In doing so, the environment is monitored to insure that areas are kept free of unpleasant odors, temperature is maintained at a comfortable level and that air quality is allowed to circulate, so that odors from indoor environmental contaminants can be minimized.

- 1. <u>If the environment is determined to be in the need of ventilation, in the form of outside</u> air, staff may obtain a key from the unit RN.
- 2. The RN will be responsible for removal of the key from the PYXIS system.
- 3. The staff member utilizing the key will be responsible for opening windows and returning the key to the RN.
- 4. <u>The RN will be responsible for returning the key to the PYXIS system.</u>
- 5. <u>The oncoming RN will verify that the key is in the PYXIS cart along with the off going RN, during an inter-shift "accounting". Both RNs will view the key in the PYXIS cart at change of shift.</u>

Removal of the Window Key from the PYXIS Medstation:

- 1. Sign into the system
- 2. <u>Go to the "remove" icon</u>
- 3. <u>Select any patient</u>
- 4. Go into the override button on the bottom of the screen
- 5. <u>One of the top items listed will say "Key Regular Misc." select this one</u>
- 6. <u>When the "remove quantity" screen appears, type in the number 1</u>
- 7. Then select the "remove now" icon on the left side of the screen on the bottom
- 8. <u>The drawer will open and the cubie containing the key will open</u>

Follow the same procedure to return the key back into the Medstation

Keys are only to be utilized to open windows for short periods of time to provide for a comfortable, healthy and safe environment. The key needs to be returned immediately and will be accounted for by the RN during inter-shift report.
