The contract between Yale University (the "Contractor") and the Connecticut Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (the "Department" or "Agency"), which was last executed by the parties on 9/1/15, and subsequently amended on 2/29/16, 4/14/16 and 6/8/16, is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. <u>Maximum Contract Amount:</u> The total maximum amount payable under this contract is increased by \$203,361 from \$38,499,746 to \$38,703,107.
 - Funding is added to provide for negotiated salary increases and to increase staffing as mutually agreed upon through the Contractor's Department-approved State Fiscal Year 2017 Operating Budget.

All terms and conditions of the original Contract, and any subsequent amendments thereto, which were not modified by this Amendment remain in full force and effect.
