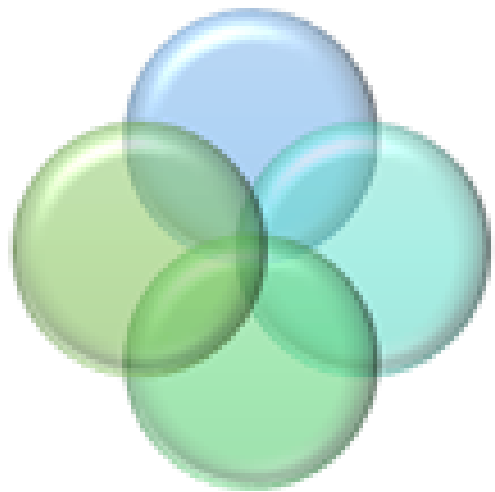

CT Assembly Public Act 24-19: AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE PEDIATRIC HOSPICE WORKING GROUP

Response tour 2025 report

1) *On and before March 1, 2025, the working group shall be responsible for the following:*

- (A) Reviewing existing hospice services for pediatric patients across the state;*
- (B) Making recommendations for appropriate levels of hospice services for pediatric patients across the state; and*
- (C) Evaluating payment and funding options for pediatric hospice care.*

Our proposal: Developing a framework

2) **On and after March 1, 2025, and before July 1, 2026,** the working group shall be responsible for developing recommendations for the establishment of a Children's Health, Advocacy, Management and Palliative Care program and, within such program, a Pediatric Palliative and Hospice Care Center of Excellence pilot program, as described in the working group's report submitted pursuant to subdivision (1) of subsection (f) of this section, including, but not limited to, recommendations regarding

- (A)** appropriations necessary to establish such program and pilot program,
- (B)** requirements for the operation of the pilot program, including, but not limited to, staff and facility requirements,
- (C)** education and curriculum requirements for nurses participating in the pilot program or providing pediatric palliative or hospice care services, and
- (D)** any licensing or certification requirements necessary for the operation of the pilot program or expanding the provision of pediatric palliative or hospice care services in the state.

Simply said, our WG already has permission to move forward in developing a solution, but our February report needs to define key actions and identify the necessary funding to help us accomplish this effort
