My name is Raymond Pech. I am from Barkhamsted, and am serving my 5th term as a Selectman. However, my thoughts stem from pure geography, not from my position as a Selectman. It is absurd that Barkhamsted is in the 1st Congressional District, not the 5th. We are a small, rural town, as is much of the 5th District. The "map" of the district looks like a scrawny hawk, with Hartford being the body, and the neck arcing up and over the western suburbs (Simsbury, Canton, etc.), with the head alighting in Barkhamsted. It makes no sense that those towns, which are east of Barkhamsted, are in the 5th district, while we are in the 1st. I realize that population must be considered in redistricting, but there must be a better way. Our voice is insignificant compared to Hartford, West Hartford, Glastonbury and many other towns in the 1st. We have much more in common, including population, with the other towns in the 5th.
