

VANITY PLATE REQUESTS

A dot will separate letters from numbers. All letters are equally spaced. No dashes or extra spaces between letters are allowed. (Example: if plate number ABC123 is ordered, it will appear as ABC•123.)

List plate request in order of preference. First available preference will be ordered. THE ORDER CANNOT BE CHANGED.

3.	6.

Every attempt will be made to accommodate your request, however, the Department of Motor Vehicles reserves the right to deny issuance of certain requests.

VANITY PLATE OPTIONS


- A. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6 letters. Plates manufactured with all letters may include a dot.
- B. 1 letter followed by 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5 numbers.
- C. 2 letters followed by 1, 2, 3 or 4 numbers.
- D. 3 letters followed by 1, 2, or 3 numbers.
- E. 4 letters followed by 1 or 2 numbers.
- F. 5 letters followed by 1 number.
- G. 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 numbers followed by 1 letter.
- H. 1, 2, 3 or 4 numbers followed by 2 letters.
- I. 1 or 2 numbers followed by 3 or 4 letters.
- J. 1 number followed by 5 letters.
- K. Numbers: 0001 thru and including 9999.
- L. Numbers: 000001 thru and including 9999999.

NOTE: Six numbers will be separated by a dot (Example: 999•999)







***Note** you have a new chance to help Connecticut's environment with the Connecticut Greenways license plate. Thirty-five dollars (fifty for special order plates) of a one-time charge (see fees on application) from each sale will be deposited into a special fund at the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection to help develop greenways around the state.*

What are greenways?

- Greenways are linear open spaces, which can:
- provide corridors for the migration of birds and wildlife;
 - become trails for non-motorized transportation or recreation, such as hiking, biking, horseback riding or roller blading;
 - buffer rivers, streams, ridgelines, and other natural features;
 - protect scenic vistas or preserve cultural and historic resources;
 - connect existing areas of open land or recreational trails from town to town or state to state.

There are many greenways in Connecticut already.

These include the Farmington Canal Trail, the Airline and Hop River Linear State Park Trails, the Blue-blazed trail system, and the Larkin State Bridle Trail. Other greenways protect such important natural resources as ridgelines and river valleys. Many more such projects are currently being planned or developed. Your purchase of a greenways plate will help to insure that these systems of trails and corridors will continue to grow and improve.



Each year, the DEP will award small grants of up to \$5000 to municipalities, regional planning organizations, and non-profit groups for greenway projects. Eligible activities will include planning and design work, placement of signs, informational and educational materials, and other non-construction activities.

Someday you may be able to hop on your bike and ride from New Haven to the Massachusetts border and beyond. Or paddle in a canoe on long stretches of the Housatonic and Connecticut Rivers, enjoying unbroken scenic vistas. You will have safe and beautiful places for family excursions or quiet spots for getting back to nature. Find out what is happening in your city or town. Get involved. It has been said that *greenways connect the places we live with the places we love*. Make that connection. Buy a Connecticut Greenways license plate today!

Instructions for obtaining a Connecticut Greenways Plate.

1. Vehicles with passenger (including handicapped), commercial, combination, camp/boat trailer, and camper registrations are eligible for the Greenways marker plates. (Motorcycles are NOT eligible).
2. Fill out application – please PRINT. If plates are to be mailed to a different address, please specify on a separate sheet.
3. Make check or money order payable to "DMV."*
4. Cut completed application on dotted lines and mail with check or money order to: **Special Interest Plate Program, 60 State Street, Wethersfield, CT 06161-6001.**
